OUR ETHOS

One of the trust's objectives is to work with children and young people with challenging behaviour, particularly those excluded from mainstream education due to persistent absenteeism. By using arts education to channel young people's energy and creativity we aim to increase their attendance at school and decrease the likelihood of their involvement in crime or antisocial behaviour.

OUR COURSES

We offer a variety of art-based courses at Entry level, Level 1 (Grade D at GCSE) and Level 2 (Grade A-C GCSE) by providing embedded literacy and numeracy classes to enable learners to achieve an accredited standard of education.

At the end of the course the learners will receive an in-house certificate outlining the subjects covered, as well as an OCR qualification in Literacy and Numeracy.

All our courses take place at our modern art centre in Clapham SW4. It is a one minute walk from mainline station Clapham High Street and a two minute walk from Clapham North tube station on the Northern Line. Numerous buses run frequently along Clapham High Road.

All our teachers are qualified professionals with current CRB checks.

COURSE INFORMATION

Art Alive courses are aimed at young people between the age of 14-19. We specialise in learners with challenging behaviour excluded from mainstream education.

Our courses are offered to learners from schools, Pupil Referral Units and YOT from the London Borough of Lambeth.

- Each session takes 5 students
- 12-week course at Entry Level, Level 1 and Level 2
- 2 hours per session (6 hours per week) includes 1 hour teaching embedded Literacy & Numeracy, 1 hour (vocational) practical class
- Courses provide a foundation for progression to each level
- Candidates are assessed through coursework and exams in literacy and numeracy
- No previous experience needed
- We aim where possible to provide 2 weeks work experience depending on availability.

COST PER LEARNER

Each learner costs £600 over a 12 week period ie £50 per learner per session.
